- Concerns were raised about changes in the PAD program due to a manufacturer no longer participating, affecting access to HIV medications. ADAP was suggested as an alternative for clients impacted.
- Discussion also covered upcoming 340B changes including rebate systems and limitations on medication dispensing. These could reduce funding for supplemental services like PrEP labs and co-pays.
