Review new developments of "Ending the Epidemic, A Plan for America" and State of New Jersey's Ending the Epidemic Initiative (Discussion)

- HRSA released a program letter regarding the Integrated Plan. They will be reaching out to jurisdictions to let them know what they need from their plans.
- CDC is combining all their HIV prevention money into one division. Instead of Ryan White Parts it could be transitioned. This is all in the preliminary stages and subject to change.
- Providers need to be aware of the restraints from HRSA on different TGA/EMA's and how some of the requirements differ in different locations. It could also be under different funding.

Review of Service Standards

- HRSA's guidance is that the Planning Councils job is to explain what we are funding.
- Under a service category the Planning Council is funding certain activities.
- Planning Council will be informing clients as to what is available under a certain service standard
- CR staff (Deryk & Thomas) gave an overview of service standards for a few service categories and the different components that encompass the documents
- It was discussed that the document should be more plain language
- The Planning Council was comfortable with the format
- CR will email the documents out to the Planning Council once they are completed

 - Undocumented Uninsurable clients
 - Demographic data such as age, race and ethnicity groups
 - Geo-mapping
 - Risk characteristics
 - Recommendations from the recipient's office
 - Continuum of care data
 - Where are the HIV testing and PrEP sites in Bergen/Passaic county?

What are we using this data to determine?

Does this service category help to end the HIV epidemic?
